To help you optimize your time and to find perfect kitchen solutions, consider the following questions:

- What do I want to change in my current kitchen?

We will need the following information to make this a productive meeting:

- The "Do Not Exceed" budget for the kitchen cabinets (Your budget is used by our professionals as a design parameter. Also considered are the size of the room, the location of windows and doors, and your aesthetic preferences.)
- An idea of when you would like the project to be started, and when you would like it to be completed
- A list of features you would like to have in your new space
- Magazine pictures or photos of rooms that you like or details that you find interesting

Finalizing Your Plan and Installation

After receiving a retainer, renderings of your plans will be provided by your designer in 2-D Line Drawings, 3-D Color Prototypes, and Detailed Shop Drawings. Once you and your designer have finalized the plans, the order will be placed by Artistic Kitchens & Baths. Your AKB designer coordinates the cabinet installation in an efficient, smooth process.
